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## **REGULATIONS OF VII TASHKENT INTERNATIONAL MARATHON**

## **I. MARATHON GOALS AND OBJECTIVES**

- popularize healthy lifestyles and running.
- unite athletes and running enthusiasts from different countries.
- show Tashkent as a modern city where big sporting events can be held.
- attract participants and tourists from all over the world.
- organize convenient routes and conditions for the marathon.
- motivate people to do sports regularly.

## **II. MARATHON ORGANIZERS**

2.1. The organizers of the marathon are:

- Central Asian Academy of Running and Walking,
- Athletics Federation of Uzbekistan,
- Central Asian Athletics Association,
- As well as other organisations that help with the marathon.

2.2. The event is supported by:

- Ministries of: foreign affairs, defence, health, digital technology, interior, emergencies;
- Ministry of Sports of Uzbekistan,
- Tashkent city Khokimiyat,
- Olympic Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan;
- Customs Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan;
- National Guard;
- Uzbekneftegaz Company;
- National TV and Radio Company and Information Agency of Uzbekistan;
- Agency for Information and Mass Communications;
- The Republican School of Sports Excellence in Track and Field Athletics;
- Central Asian Association of Track and Field Athletics;
- Amateur running clubs.
- The main judging panel of the event is the Athletics Federation of Uzbekistan.

### **III. EVENT FINANCING**

3.1 The Tashkent International Marathon is organised at the expense of:

- Ministry of Sport of Uzbekistan
- Ministry of Higher Education, Science and Innovation
- Ministry of School and Preschool Education
- Agency for Youth Affairs
- Khokimiyat of Tashkent
- Uzbekneftegaz JSC
- Organizers, sponsors and benefactors
- Voluntary contributions of participants (if they are not prohibited by the legislation of Uzbekistan)

3.2 The Central Asian Academy of Running and Walking together with the Uzbekistan Athletics Federation and the Central Asian Athletics Association are responsible for organizing the marathon. Hereinafter they are referred to as the Organizer.

The Organizer has the obligation to:

- Procurement of goods and services for the marathon without state electronic bidding.
- Involvement of foreign experts to improve the organization.
- Preparation of souvenirs and organization of sales outlets at the marathon.
- Making changes to the budget (without increasing the total amount) and using all funds received only for future events.

### **IV. EVENT INFORMATION**

4.1 The VII Tashkent International Marathon will take place on 12-13 April 2025 in Tashkent, Uzbekistan.

4.2 Start location

- 12 April (Kids Run, Participants with disabilities, Nordic Walking):
  - Furkat Street, Beshagach Square, Magic City Park.
- 13 April (Marathon, Half Marathon, 10 km, 3km):
  - Yangi Uzbekiston Street (landmark Yangi Uzbekiston Park).

#### 4.3 Distances and start times

##### **12 April 2025**

- **08:00** - 1 km (Kids Run, participants with disabilities)
- **08:00** - 3 km (Kids Run, Nordic walking)

##### **13 April 2025**

- **08:00** - marathon (42 km), half-marathon (21 km), 10 km race, 3 km race

### **V. CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION**

5.1 The competition is held in individual championship.

5.2 Everyone can participate in the marathon, regardless of citizenship, both athletes and amateurs.

Men and women from 15 years old (must be 15 years old by the date of the competition) can participate in the 10km, 21km, 42km, 3km and Nordic walking races.

Within the framework of the VII Tashkent International Marathon, age categories divided by gender are provided for participants in the Marathon (42km), Half Marathon (21km) and 10km races.

Age categories:

- 15–34 years
- 35–49 years
- 50+ years

The winners of each age category (1st-3rd place) will receive valuable prizes from the event partners.

The age of participants of Kids Run children's races:

- 1 km - children from 5 to 9 years old (age on the day of the competition).
- 3 km - children from 10 to 14 years old (age on the day of the competition).

5.3 Both individuals and organizations can participate. For this purpose, it is necessary to:

- Fill in the application form on the official form (prescribed sample).
- You can get the form by writing to [uzb@mf.worldathletics.uz](mailto:uzb@mf.worldathletics.uz) (from 2 February to 2 April 2025).
- Register on the website [yugur.uz](http://yugur.uz) or [perfend.com](http://perfend.com)
- Fill in the participant questionnaire
- Do it from 2 February to 2 April 2025 until 23:59.

5.4 All participants must agree to the terms and conditions of the public offer by ticking  in the appropriate box when paying for a slot on the [yugur.uz](http://yugur.uz) website

5.5 Participants of the marathon, half marathon, 10 km, 3 km, Kids Run and Nordic walking must pay the start fee (Appendix No.1) when registering at [yugur.uz](http://yugur.uz) or [perfend.com](http://perfend.com)

5.6 If the money has been credited by mistake, it can be refunded within 30 working days after it has been credited to the organiser's account, provided that the cancellation request has been submitted within three days after payment of the entry fee.

5.7 Elite athletes, veterans and invited guests included in the established quota are exempted from paying the entry fee.

5.8. There are 5 seats available for the Member States of the Central Asian Association:

- 2 males
- 2 females
- 1 representative

These participants receive:

- Free accommodation and meals from 11 to 14 April 2025
- Marathon distance participant package

5.9. The Organizing Committee may invite elite athletes by making arrangements with their managers or National Federations. In this case the committee will pay:

- Air ticket
- Participation costs (arrival and participation fees)
- Visa expenses
- Accommodation and meals in Tashkent
- Other necessary expenses

5.10. All other participants may participate at the expense of the sending organisation or at their own expense.

5.11. All expenses for participation of teams from the regions of Uzbekistan, the Republic of Karakalpakstan and Tashkent city are covered by the sending organisations.

## **VI. PROCEDURE FOR ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS AND RECEIVING THE PARTICIPANT'S PACKAGE**

6.1. How do I apply to participate?

- Fill in the application form on the official form (prescribed sample).

- To get the form, email [uzb@mf.worldathletics.uz](mailto:uzb@mf.worldathletics.uz) (2 February to 2 April 2025).
- You can also register at [yugur.uz](http://yugur.uz) and [perfend.com](http://perfend.com).

6.2. Every participant in the marathon, half marathon, 10km, 3km, Kids Run, Nordic Walk, and athletes and enthusiasts with disabilities receives:

- Start number with chip (1 piece)
- 4 pins
- bag
- T-shirt with marathon logo
- Cap with marathon logo

On the website [yugur.uz](http://yugur.uz) participants can additionally buy sports uniforms and accessories from JOMA for a fee.

6.3. How do I get a starter pack?

The participant must come to the issuing point in person on 10, 11 April 2025 from 10:00 to 20:00 and provide an identity document and/ or a child's identity document.

## **VII. RESULTS REGISTRATION**

7.1 A transponder timing system will be used at the competitions.

7.2 The final results will be published on the website [yugur.uz](http://yugur.uz).

7.3 The Organizing Committee of the competitions does not guarantee 100% of personal results for each competitor under the following conditions:

- Incorrectly attached chip;
- Chip demagnetization;
- Disqualification by the decision of the Judging Board.

7.4 A competitor's result is only recorded if the start number is correctly placed.

**7.5. IMPORTANT:** *Winners and prize-winners are determined by:*

- Kids Run(1km,3km), 3km adults, Nordic Walking - CHIP TIME
- Marathon(42km), Half Marathon(21km), 10km - GUN TIME

**7.6. Terminology when outputting results:**

- CHIP TIME - A competitor's personal time. Time from crossing the starting mats to crossing the finishing mats by the competitor
- GUN TIME - A competitor's finishing time. The time from the start of the starting salvo until the competitor crosses the finishing mats
- CR – Championship Record
- DSQ – Disqualified
- DNF – Did not finish
- DNS – Did not start

**7.7. Marathon time limit:**

- Total time for the marathon is 6 hours.
- The intermediate limit is 21 kilometers in 3 hours.
- If a marathon participant fails to meet the 3-hour time limit at the half marathon mark, he/she will be withdrawn from the course and will receive a finisher's medal for the half marathon.
- The total time for the half marathon is 3 hours
- If a half marathon participant fails to meet the 3-hour time limit at the half marathon mark, he/she will be withdrawn from the course and will not receive a finisher's medal.

## **VIII. CLAIMS AND DISPUTE RESOLUTION**

8.1. All claims are considered by the panel of judges according to the World Athletics Rules.

8.2. All claims must be made in writing within 30 minutes of the official announcement of the results.

## **IX. REWARDING**

**9.1. Awarding the winners of the marathon (42 km)**

Prize places: participants of the marathon (42 km), who took 1-3 places in the absolute championship among men and women, are awarded with cash prizes (Appendix №2).



Bonus for setting the Uzbekistan record:

- Men: 1st place and faster result 2:07:02
- Women: 1st place and faster result 2:29:28
- Bonus - 15 million soum.

9.2. Prizes: participants of the half marathon (21 km), who took 1-3 places in the absolute championship among men and women, are awarded with cash prizes (Appendix №2).

Bonus for setting the Uzbekistan record:

- Men: 1st place and faster than 1:01:48
- Women: 1st place and faster result 1:14:02
- Bonus - 10 million soums.

9.3. Prizes: participants of the 10 km race, who took 1-3 places in the absolute championship among men and women, are awarded with cash prizes:

- 1st place - 9,000,000 soums
- 2nd place - 6,000,000 soums
- 3rd place - 3 000 000 soums

9.4. Prizes: participants of the 3 km race among sportsmen and amateurs, who took 1-3 places among men and women, are awarded cash prizes:

- 1st place - 5,000,000 soums
- 2nd place - 3,000,000 soums
- 3rd place - 1,500,000 soums

9.4. All participants who successfully complete the marathon (42km), half marathon (21km), 10km, 3km, Kids Run (1km and 3km) and Nordic Walk (3km) distances will receive finisher's medals to signify their achievements.

*Important: Marathon participants (athletes and amateurs) must complete the marathon course within the set time limit in order to receive a medal.*

9.5. The title partner of the event has the right to provide valuable prizes to reward the best athletes from Uzbekistan in the marathon (42 km) and half-marathon (21 km) distances.

9.6. The organizers and sponsors of the event may award additional prizes to winners, medalists and competitors.

Prizes may be provided for:

- Athletes with disabilities
- Sports veterans
- Children taking part in the race
- Other categories of participants as decided by the organizers

9.7. The prize-winning athletes are obliged to come to the awarding ceremony wearing the official uniform of the event (T-shirt and cap with logo). The medal winners in their categories will be invited to the podium.

## **X. DISQUALIFICATION**

10.1. The organizers have the right to disqualify a competitor if:

- the competitor started the race after the start area was closed;
- the competitor started the race before the official start;
- the competitor went to the start without a start number;
- the competitor violates the rules of the competition;
- the competitor does not pay attention to the instructions and remarks of the organizers, judges or the chief physician of the competition;
- the competitor started the race not from his/her time cluster.

10.2. Participants will be excluded from the final protocol if:

- the competitor shortened the course;
- the competitor ran under a different number - registered to another person;
- the competitor used an improvised means of transport (bicycle, scooter, etc.);
- the competitor ran a distance for which he/she was not registered;
- the competitor ran without the official number of the particular competition or the number was hidden under the clothes;
- the competitor started the race from outside the start area.

## **XI. DOPING CONTROL**

11.1. Anti-Doping Agency officers have the authority to selectively collect doping samples from Athletes.

11.2. Prize-winning athletes who have had their tests taken will only be able to receive prize money payments once they have received their doping sample results and confirmed the absence of banned substances.
